Grammar Exercise

Part 1: change the sentences into questions.

例: It will rain tomorrow. → Will it rain tomorrow?

1. He will go shopping later. Will he go shopping later?
2. They will be back soon. Will they be back soon?
3. I will be safe. Will I be safe?
4. We will have ramen. Shall we have ramen? (提案ですから。)

Part 2: change these sentences to the Future Simple tense.

例: We usually go shopping on Sundays. → We will go shopping (*on Sunday*).

1. Every weekend my sister and I play tennis.
My sister and I will play tennis (*on the weekend*).
2. We often go to the library after school.
We will go to the library (*after school*).
3. Sometimes I help my mom around the house.
I will help my mom around the house (*this evening*).
4. When I finish my homework, I usually play computer games.
I will play computer games (*when I finish my homework*).

Part 3: contract the sentences.

例: I will go to school today. → I'll go to school today.

1. It will snow tomorrow. It'll snow tomorrow.
2. They will not do anything today. They won't do anything today.
3. We will go to Hokkaido this winter, but we will not ski.
We'll go to Hokkaido this winter, but we won't ski.
